<b>National resources with Ohio data</b>	
<b><u>American Community Survey</u></b>	Data on demographics, including various socioeconomic status, health status, and other indicators. <i>Source: United States Census Bureau</i>
<b><u>County Health Rankings &amp; Roadmaps: State Report 2022 Ohio</u></b>	A report ranking all Ohio counties on several health metrics. <i>Source: University of Wisconsin Population Health Institute</i>
<b><u>National survey of children's health</u></b> (note data is state level)	Rich data on child health nationally that includes factors related to neighborhood, school, and family dynamics. <i>Source: The Child and Adolescent Health Measurement Initiative</i>
<b><u>PLACES: Local data for better health</u></b>	A database of population-level analysis and community estimates of health measures to all counties, places, census tracts, and ZIP Code Tabulation Areas across the United States. <i>Source: Centers for Disease Control and Prevention</i>
<b>Ohio specific resources</b>	
<b><u>Ohio healthy students profiles</u></b>	Localized profiles include information on health conditions and educational indicators and health care utilization for students enrolled in Medicaid. <i>Source: Ohio Department of Education and Workforce</i>
<b><u>Ohio behavioral risk factor surveillance system 2019 annual report</u></b>	Resource that describes a wide variety of health indicators, including: heart disease, asthma, childhood asthma, cancer, kidney disease, diabetes, depression, smoking, binge drinking. <i>Source: Ohio Department of Health</i>
<b><u>Ohio state epidemiological workgroup county assessment data profiles</u></b>	County level profiles outlining numerous factors including behavioral health diagnoses and mental health services utilization. <i>Source: Ohio Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services</i>
<b><u>Ohio School Report Cards</u></b>	Yearly reports with information on school building and district demographics, academic outcomes, and ratings. <i>Source: Ohio Department of Education and Workforce</i>
<b><u>Public Children Services Association of Ohio factbook</u></b>	Comprehensive resource for county level data on Ohio's children services agencies. <i>Source: Public children services association of Ohio</i>
<b><u>Healthy Northeast Ohio Health Indicator List</u></b>	A database of dozens of health indicators, searchable by county or census tract. <i>Source: Healthy Northeast Ohio</i>
<b><u>OHYES! Ohio Healthy Youth Environments Survey Data</u></b>	Results of a regular state-wide survey of students in grades 7-12 that measures health risks and behaviors. <i>Source: Ohio Department of Health</i>
